We verify all enrollment questions with the Indian Arts and Crafts Board in Washington, D.C. and follow the guidelines of the 1990 Indian Arts & Crafts Board Act.

1. A copy of a tribal enrollment card. Verification of only degree of Indian blood is not acceptable.
2. A copy of a letter from your tribe or agency on official letterhead and signed by a senior tribal official or enrollment specialist clearly verifying your enrollment.
3. The IACB Act allows a non-enrolled Indian artist to be certified, in writing on tribal stationary, by the tribe of his/her descent as an "Indian artisan" of that tribe's descent. A copy of that certification is acceptable.
